



## **Tournament Discounts and How to Get a Rating During a Tournament**

Teams who have a certified referee(s) on their roster have the right to choose to provide the up ref for both work assignments. When doing so, they get a \$25 discount on the entry fee. This is part of the entry process in the tab where you indicate referees and scorers. There are rules associated with this discount.

- You must request it during the entry process.
- You cannot request it after the Wednesday before the tournament or onsite
- If you take the discount and then don't have any referee, you must tell your coordinator and host if you know in advance of the tournament, or the host and Head Ref the second that you arrive at the tournament. At that point you will need to give the host a check for \$100; \$75 is the no ref fee and \$25 is to refund the discount

**\*\***If you elect to ref all of your matches to get the discount, your referees CANNOT get a rating during that tournament. Ratings can only be done when you go up in place of the uniformed ref. If you haven't paid for a uniformed ref, there is no one available to do the rating. If you need a rating or are a team rep with a ref on your roster, make sure that you schedule a situation when you don't take the discount so that the ref can get rated.
