



Most Commonly Asked Questions about Seedings and Results

1. Why are the results not posted for a tournament?

- Results being posted for a tournament depend on when I receive all the required information from the Tournament Director.
- Once all the information is received, each scoresheet is checked and all results are double checked. Then information is posted on the website.
- When there are no delays in receiving the information, results are posted within 14 days after a tournament has happened.
- If information is not sent in a timely fashion, the results are delayed in being posted.

2. How are the seedings calculated?

- Please read the Seedings Index Description on the CHRVA website. Go to www.chrva.org >> “Juniors” tab at the top >> “Girls Results” on the left toolbar >> “Seeding Index” button at the top >> “Seeding Index Description” button at the top.

3. Why aren't the results from my last tournament included in the Seedings Index for Regionals?

- In order to properly seed the CHRVA Regional Tournaments, a cutoff date is selected by the Region for each age group. Tournaments held between the cutoff date and the date of the Regional Tournament will not be included in the seedings.

4. How are the teams seeded for CHRVA tournaments?

- The seedings for tournaments hosted by clubs in CHRVA are done by the Age Group Coordinators.

5. The posted results for my team are wrong; who do I contact to correct this?

- Send a polite email to the Seedings Coordinator, jr.girls.results.coord@chrva.org, requesting the results be reviewed. Please include the tournament date, host, age group, team, and the results in question. The Coordinator will review the request and make any necessary changes.
