As Charles mentioned in his president's article, during the summer, a combination of Board members and staff met to discuss the future of CHRVA. We brought in a consultant, who helped us focus and put us through exercises in order to come up with a three-year plan. This plan focuses on three areas: governance; membership and recruitment; and technology.

One of the membership goals is to engage more of the membership in what we do. We would prefer to have members of these groups who are at-large members...specifically those who are not already involved in the leadership. We are looking for members who would like to participate in discussions, projects, or even to act as testers or readers. Do you have interest in any of these topics, but maybe don't have time to serve as a Board member? This could be a good way for you to participate without the full commitment of being on the Board. And, if you are thinking about becoming at Board member in the future, this might be a way to get your feet wet.

Governance: Evaluate the Board; evaluate the committees; create users guides that would be separate from the Handbook. Ways to volunteer: Become a member of one of the discussion groups; proof guides; test the guides as an end user, etc.

Membership and Recruitment: Ideas and projects that will engage the membership and promote membership to others. Ways to volunteer: Become a member of one of the discussion groups; investigate possible projects; work on projects, etc.

Technology: Are we using the best possible available technologies? Ways to volunteer: Become a member of one of the discussion groups; test the technologies or programs as an end user, etc.
