



NEW JUNIOR OFFICIALS CLINIC PROCESS

The region has recognized that management of the referee and scorekeeper clinics in the past has been a challenge. Previously, there were no formal processes for registering for or keeping track of attendees at the various clinics. To address that problem, CHRVA has implemented a new online registration system for the junior officiating clinics. All people who wish to attend a clinic **MUST** register prior to attending a clinic. Each clinic is limited in the number of attendees, so non-registered walkups will not be allowed to participate if the clinic is full.

This new process is an attempt to effectively manage the number of attendees at each clinic. By doing so, we can avoid situations where, due to lack of space, some clinics were forced to turn away people who drove great distances. This process will also provide the region an accurate account of an individual's attendance.

The clinic schedule will be posted to the junior's portion of the region website (www.chrva.org) no later than mid-September. Note that for the 2011-2012 season, this process is only in place for the juniors. Below are some important things to remember:

Start Times

- 8:30 Registration
- 9:00 Scorekeeper Clinic (ends approximately 11:30)
- 12:30 Referee Clinic (ends approximately 2:30)

Registration Information

- All attendees **MUST** pre-register for the junior official clinics
- Walk-ups are subject to be turned away if clinic is full
- The \$10 fee is good **ONLY** for the date that is selected
- The fee is good for both scorekeeper and referee clinics on the same day
- Each clinic has a limit on the number of attendees so **REGISTER EARLY!**
- Clinic registration closes the Thursday night prior to the clinic or when the clinic is full
- Emails must be unique for each registration submission
- However, you can register up to three (3) people in one registration session
- Absolutely no refunds or change of dates. However, the paid registration is transferable to another person **ONLY** for the date and clinic selected at the time of registration
- Pre-registered attendees must check in to the clinic no later than 8:45 a.m.
- Registered attendees who complete the junior referee course and achieve a passing grade on the test will receive red and yellow cards and a flipping coin.

Upon the completion of your registration, you will receive a confirmation and/or a "ticket" for the event. Remember to bring one or the other with you to the clinic. Good luck and have a great season!
