Notice to all Coaches, Parents and Players

- In order to support the efforts of player officials, it is a requirement that all work teams **will have at least one adult present on the court during their work match.** Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action in accordance with the CHRVA Handbook as a **failure to supply a work team.**
- **Harassment or abuse (verbally or physically) of work teams or players by coaches, players or spectators (including parents) will not be tolerated.** Tournament Directors have the authority to remove anyone from the facility, who, in their opinion, is abusive or disrupting play. First referees have the authority to remove players, coaches, parents and spectators from the game or facility. Coaches and players will be disciplined according to the CHRVA Handbook.

It is important to take both these points seriously as sanctions range from temporary suspension up to suspension for life from all CHRVA and USAV sanctioned activities (both adult and juniors) for infractions.
